The Kewanee PTO would like to invite your son or daughter to a summer enrichment program. This program is open to all KCUD #229 students entering grades 4, 5 or 6. The Summer Culture College is one week long, running from June 15 to June 19, 2009. The Culture College will be held at Kewanee High School.

The purpose of the program is to provide students with an opportunity to explore different classes with interesting concepts and activities. All classes will be taught by volunteer, certified teachers, with assistance from high school and junior high students. No grades, nor credits, will be given to the students for taking the classes. Good behavior is expected in order to remain in the classes.

Registration: Registration is on a first-come, first-serve basis. Parents wishing to enroll a child in the program should return the completed registration form and a check for **\$30**, (payable to the "Kewanee PTO") to Central School or Irving School **by June 5**.

Important Guidelines:

- No refunds for missed classes
- Behavior problems with other students and or staff will result in dismissal and no refund.
- The program is one week long, June 15-19, 2009
- The time is 9:00-12:00
- The location will be Kewanee High School. Enter at the "Good's Gym" entrance
- There will be 3 sections that students will be assigned to. Each student will travel to different rooms for 3 classes, each day.

(Schedule will be given on the first day of class)

- The fee is \$30 (that is \$6 a day or \$2 per hour!!)
- Maximum enrollment is 20 students per class
- Students will move from classroom to classroom, with a 5 minute break between each class.
- Class Times: 1st period, 9:00-9:55
2nd period, 10:00-10:55
3rd period, 11:00-11:55
- Parents may attend an Open House, on the last day (Friday, June 15) from 11:00-12:00, to go through their child's classes and see their projects.
