ABCD is an after school program offered to students in Kindergarten through 6th grade. Students receive homework assistance and academic enrichment activities from a certified staff. There is a minimal fee to attend the program. ABCD Registration forms are available on-line and at Irving, Belle, or Central Schools. The program will be offered the following days and times:

- REMOTE HOMEWORK HELP starting Tuesday, August 25 - Thursday, September 3, 2020, from 3:30-5 with live help from program staff. We will be using Google Meets.
- In-person ABCD after school from 1:40-5:00 **at Irving School** starting Tuesday, September 8, 2020.
- We are planning to keep remote homework help ongoing once in-person programming starts. More information will be available as those decisions are made.

Please note: Students may only attend ABCD in-person after school programming on days they are in attendance at school as we will be following the same schedule as Kewanee District 229 which is: Mondays: all remote, Tues/Thurs A Day, and Wed/Fri B Day. Remote homework help is still offered on remote learning days.

Also, ALL COVID-19 school regulations will be followed during the ABCD after school program including mask wearing while following the social distance guidelines.
